

What is an Alien Number?

- An Alien Number or A# is a unique number given to a non-citizen by U.S. immigration authorities.
- It is a 9-digit number that may have the letter 'A' before it.
- The A# is very important and often required for immigration processes. It is a good idea to memorize the number and to write it down somewhere safe and accessible.
- If someone is detained, you will need their A# and country of birth to locate them using the ICE Detainee Locator System: <https://locator.ice.dhs.gov/odls/#/search>
- The A# is NOT a Social Security Number, Subject ID #, or Event No.



Where do I find an Alien Number?

- You can find the A# in immigration documents (e.g., work authorization, Notice to Appear, Court Hearing Notice, USCIS documents, Form I-797 Notices, Green Card)
- Depending on the immigration document, it can also be called a File # or USCIS #

Qu'est-ce qu'un numéro A ?

- Un numéro A est un numéro unique attribué à un non citoyen par les autorités de l'immigration des États-Unis. Il s'agit d'un numéro à 9 chiffres pouvant être précédés de la lettre A.
- Le numéro A est très important et souvent nécessaire pour les procédures d'immigration. Le mémoriser et l'écrire à un endroit sûr et accessible est une bonne idée.
- Si quelqu'un est détenu, vous aurez besoin de son numéro A et son pays de naissance pour le localiser dans le système de localisation des détenus d'ICE : <https://locator.ice.dhs.gov/odls/#/search>
- Le numéro A n'est PAS un numéro de sécurité sociale, un numéro ID de sujet ou un numéro d'événement.



Où trouver un numéro A ?

- Vous pouvez trouver le numéro A sur les documents d'immigration (par exemple, une autorisation de travail, une convocation, un avis d'audience, des documents de l'USCIS, les notices du formulaire I-797, une carte verte)
- En fonction du document d'immigration, ce numéro peut aussi être appelé numéro de dossier ou numéro USCIS
