WHAT YOU'RE VOTING FOR:

The offices on your ballot will vary based on where you live and what political party you are registered with.

U.S. HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

You vote for your Representative in Congress every 2 years. A congressperson can:



- Make and vote on laws affecting the United States
- Initiate laws affecting the federal budget
- Impeach federal officials

NEW YORK STATE COMPTROLLER

You vote for the Comptroller every 4 years. The Comptroller can:

- Investigate waste, fraud, and abuse of taxpayer money
- Manage the state pension fund
- Review state contracts and payments



NEW YORK STATE SENATE & ASSEMBLY

You vote for your State Senator and Member of Assembly every 2 years. State senators and assemblymembers can:

- Vote and pass laws affecting New York State
- Approve state spending
- Veto the Governor
- (Senate only) Confirm Governor's appointments of court judges
